

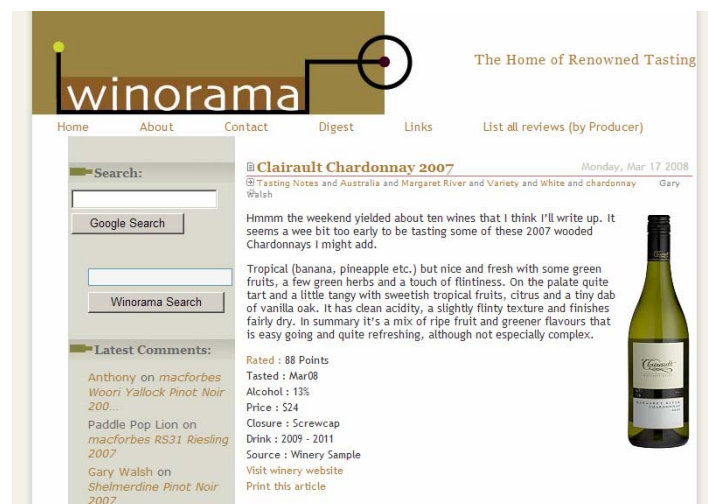
Clairault Chardonnay 2007

88/100

“Hmmm the weekend yielded about ten wines that I think I’ll write up. It seems a wee bit too early to be tasting some of these 2007 wooded Chardonnays I might add.

Tropical (banana, pineapple etc.) but nice and fresh with some green fruits, a few green herbs and a touch of flintiness. On the palate quite tart and a little tangy with sweetish tropical fruits, citrus and a tiny dab of vanilla oak.

It has clean acidity, a slightly flinty texture and finishes fairly dry. In summary it’s a mix of ripe fruit and greener flavours that is easy going and quite refreshing, although not especially complex.” Gary Walsh
