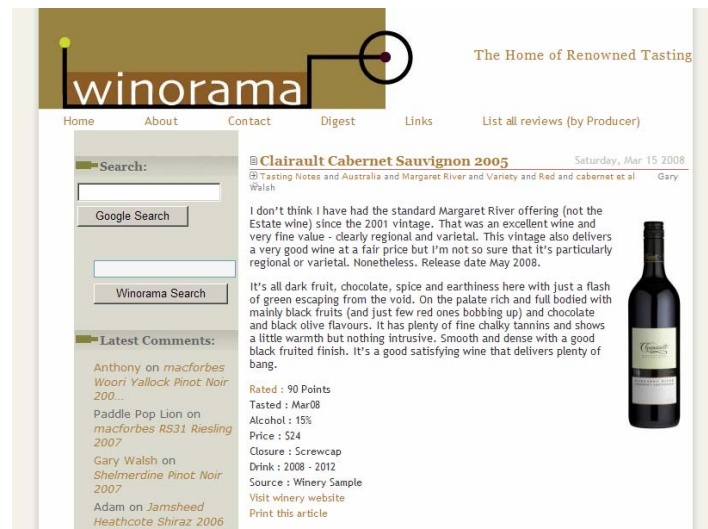


## Clairault Cabernet Sauvignon 2005

90/100

“I don’t think I have had the standard Margaret River offering (not the Estate wine) since the 2001 vintage. That was an excellent wine and very fine value - clearly regional and varietal. This vintage also delivers a very good wine at a fair price but I’m not so sure that it’s particularly regional or varietal. Nonetheless. Release date May 2008.

It’s all dark fruit, chocolate, spice and earthiness here with just a flash of green escaping from the void. On the palate rich and full bodied with mainly black fruits (and just few red ones bobbing up) and chocolate and black olive flavours. It has plenty of fine chalky tannins and shows a little warmth but nothing intrusive. Smooth and dense with a good black fruited finish. It’s a good satisfying wine that delivers plenty of bang.” Gary Walsh
