

Clairault Restaurant

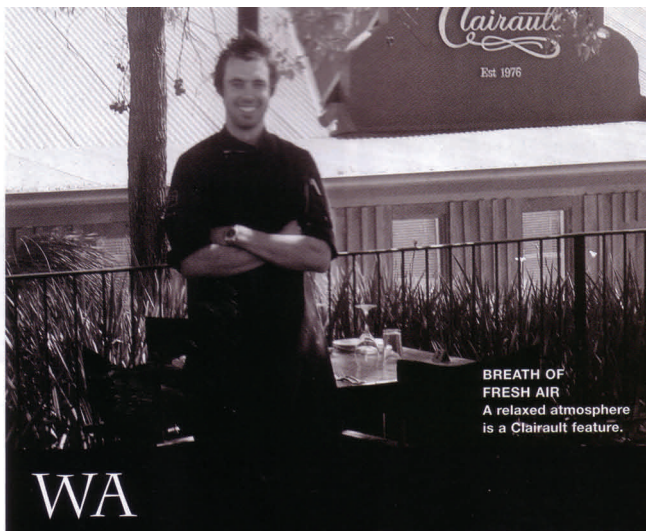

Manicured lawns about the vineyard, and bushland back drop is framed by spectacular karri trees.

Nor do changes of chef seem to have had a negative impact on Clairault, which has consistently produced cutting-edge modern Australian dishes for many years. The constant interplay of textures and flavours is a recurring theme, and the clean, striking presentation of the food will whet your appetite.

The Clairault wine range is offered by the glass or bottle. The wines have shown substantial improvement since Will Shields took over as winemaker, with the Sauvignon Blanc and the Estate Cabernet Sauvignon the best of the bunch.
